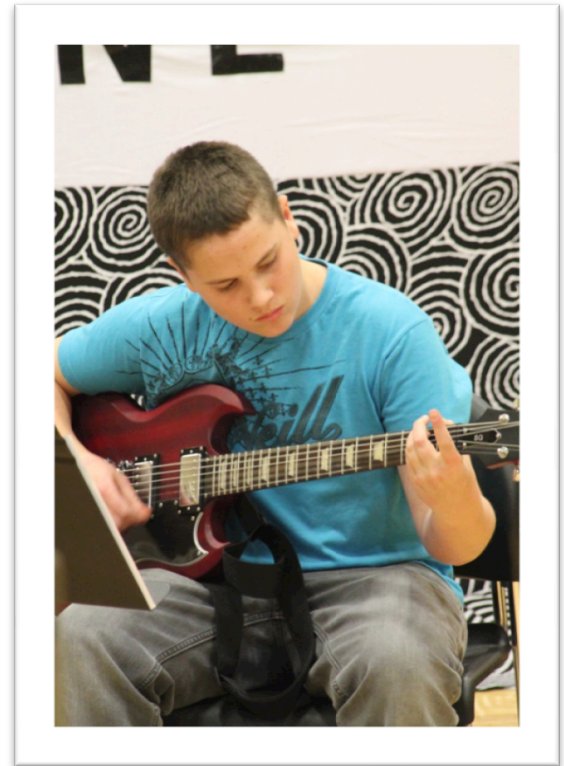

# MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL OFFERINGS

## **Riverstone Contemporary Band (Grades 6–10) \$45**

## **Fencing (Grade 3+) \$65**

**Mondays, 3:30 – 4:30**

Did you know that fencing is one of four sports featured at all of the modern Olympic Games? Come learn what a foil, sabre, and épée are while being taught technique with an emphasis on safety. Taught by Andy Gearhart. Meet in the Elementary School Multi-Purpose Room.
