




Introducing Todd Horn

He has served as an executive coach for Heads and has trained nonprofit boards in governance, strategic planning, transition management, finance, and fundraising. Additionally, Todd has served as a trustee/advisory board member to an international student program, a national organization that focuses on moral and ethical development, and an IB boarding school.



Over 17 years as Head of Kent Denver School, Todd strengthened programs, increased diversity, refined administrative systems, and developed nationally recognized programs in the arts and STEM disciplines. By building an empowered culture of life-long learning for every community member, Kent Denver was twice voted the top educational workplace in Denver. Additionally, under Todd's leadership, Kent Denver built several award-winning buildings and quadrupled the size of the endowment. Prior to his time at Kent Denver, Todd led a remote Western boarding school and developed innovative programs in technology, the arts, and experiential education.

Through his role as president of two Western accrediting independent school associations and work with the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) teaching 180 new heads of school, Todd has become known for his ability to strengthen school culture and bring out the best in educators and educational communities. Todd has been asked by the NAIS to mentor aspiring heads and serve on a variety of national task forces, most recently examining the value proposition and future of the traditional independent school model in a rapidly changing marketplace.

Todd was an early Expert in Residence at the Harvard Innovation Lab (2014-2017) and has judged entrepreneurial competitions at Harvard and Boise State University. His educational background includes degrees from Dartmouth College (B.A. in Biology), Harvard University (Ed.M. in Curriculum Design), the University of Colorado (M.B.A in Marketing), and Northern Arizona University (Ed.D. in Organizational Development).
